Changes to the start of term four

Dear Parents

A day is a long time in education at the moment. On Wednesday we sent out information outlining the dates when students will return to on-site learning. This has now changed! Yesterday we received a memo from the Education Department regarding the latest changes for the start of term four.

The information we received states that **students enrolled in Prep to Grade 6 in P-12 schools will return to on-site learning on Thursday 8th October**. Year 7 to 12 students will still resume onsite learning on Monday 12th October.

Stand-alone primary schools are able to return to on-site learning on Monday 5th October. As a P – 12 school, we have VCE students who will sit the General Achievement Test (GAT) on Wednesday 7th October. The Education Department is determined to ensure that students are able to complete the GAT without any potential disruptions.

The first six days of term four will look like this;

- Monday 5th Oct** - All students remote/flexible learning. Care/supervision program continues.
- Tuesday 6th Oct** - All students remote/flexible learning. Care/supervision program continues.
- Wednesday 7th Oct** - **Student Free Day**. VCE students sit the GAT.
No remote/flexible learning. No care/supervision program.
- Thursday 8th Oct** - **Prep – Year 6 students return to on-site learning**.
Year 7 -12 continue students remote/flexible learning.
Care/supervision program continues for years 7 -12.
- Friday 9th Oct** - Prep to Year 6 students are learning at school.
Year 7 -12 continue remote/flexible learning. Care/supervision program continues for years 7 -12.
- Monday 12th Oct** - **all students are at school** and learning onsite.
