**The last day that the canteen will be open is Friday 14th December.**




Craig invited the students to read some sections of the book, as well as engaged the students with various questions during the reading.

We were reading Mack the Quack and I was Judge Well and also a Narrator. I shook hands with some of the residents.




## 1L Drama Skits



**Year 9 Mathematics - Scale Factor Projects**

We did this task to show that we understood scale factor and could find the scale factor of different shapes. Scale factor is where you enlarge or minimize a shape. We do this by finding the length of the sides and multiplying them to find the new side length.


